

The 6/80 & MO Oxford & Cowley Club
Annual Rally 2022 – Road Run Route from/to Hatton Country World

The run will commence from the rally field on Saturday afternoon promptly at 1.00pm
Approx. 32 Miles Round Trip. Advisories/information in blue type.

1. Turn **left** out of Hatton Country World into Dark Lane, and continue on this narrow road which takes you over the M40. Continue on Dark Lane past a single-track road sign, going past the Hatton Tech Centre (the single-track road has good passing places, but watch your speed as “matey boy racer” coming the other way will not understand the value of your cherished car). When you reach the **A4189**, turn **right**, & stay on **A4189** through **Claverden** into **Henley in Arden**. (Approx 7 miles)
2. Cross the A3400 at the lights in Henley in Arden (or turn right if you want to have a look at the town) & continue across on the **A4189** towards **Redditch**, through **Oldberrow**, still towards Redditch.
3. At roundabout on the **A435**, take the **first exit** towards **Evesham** & continue on **A435** through Mappleborough Green & into **Studley**. **Refreshment stop at The Barley Mow** on the right as you enter Studley, part of the Stonehouse chain. Perfect food, friendly staff and excellent free parking for all of us. Please register your vehicle registration number as soon as you step into the premises. This is where we may all have a laugh on technology, when the Vehicle Recognition thing will not work on our “Preserved Posterity”.
4. Turn right out of car park & continue out of **Studley** on the **A435**, & shortly, **directly after junction with road** joining from the **right**, turn **left** after **Karen’s Corner** on left into **Spernal Lane**, signposted to **Spernal & Morton Bagot**. Drive slowly as not to miss **Spernal Lane**. Clear sign when you turn LEFT into this lane to **Gt. Alne village** - 6 miles of country lanes.
5. **Slight left** at T-junction with **B4089**, then shortly **bear right** as the main road bends left, into Pelham Lane at ‘**The Station House**’ (white house with the name on the front).

6. Shortly **bear left** off Pelham Lane as it bends right, & follow sign towards **Billesley, Wilmcote & Stratford** (a further 4 miles). Continue **straight across** at cross-roads as road becomes **Wood Lane**, & later turn sharp **left** towards **Wilmcote**. [Almost like a T-Junction - turn LEFT.](#)
7. Proceed along **Wilmcote Lane**, & take the **right** turn towards **Wilmcote & Mary Arden's House** ([clear brown sign post to Mary Arden's House - leading to our Place of Interest – Mary Arden's Farmhouse](#)).
8. In **Wilmcote**, turn **left** at the **Mary Arden Inn** into **Station Road** for photo stop. [Visitor Centre on left to stop for tea, & historical Elizabethan House. Line up all the cars for a great photo shoot for the magazine. Good parking.](#) On leaving, turn left out of car park & the road continues on over railway bridge as **Featherbed Lane**.
9. Turn **right** on to **A3400**, then shortly turn **left** on to **Gospel Oak Lane** (at Four Ashes car sales opposite), signposted to **Stratford Armouries & Snitterfield**.
10. After **Brickyard Farm** on the right, & **BEFORE** you get to the A46, turn **left** into **The Green** (signposted, with blue weight limit signs), following signs into **Snitterfield**. Turn **right** at the crossroads in the village on to **Smith's Lane**, then a **left** turn up the hill after a speed hump into **Church Road** which continues for a while into **Snitterfield Lane**, towards Norton Lindsey, where it becomes **Main Street**.
11. At the junction, **bear left** on to **Wolverton Road**, signposted to Alcester, then **shortly right** into **Curlieu Lane** at the double-fronted brick house with a stand-alone red post box on the right. At the end of the lane, turn **right** on to the **A4189**, then **immediately left into Dark Lane**, signposted to **Hatton Country World**.
12. Continue on this narrow road which takes you over the M40, & back to the entrance of Hatton Country World on your right.
